About the role

The Editor-in-Chief (EiC) is responsible for overseeing the scholarly development and publication of the *European Journal of Sport Science* (EJSS). Working closely with the ECSS Publishing Manager, the Official Journal Publishing Partner (Taylor & Francis), and the EJSS editorial team, the EiC will grow and develop the journal in terms of its quality, ranking, international reputation and other strategic areas, and also ensure the smooth publication of the journal in terms of submissions, peer review and workflow and online publication.

General responsibilities

General responsibilities for this role include:

- Ensuring the smooth operation of the journal
- Leading and developing the journal's editorial team
- Growing and developing the journal, e.g. in terms of quality, ranking, international reputation
- Supporting and contributing to the journal's strategic development
- Supporting and contributing to the journal's social media and marketing strategy
- Staying up-to-date with publishing trends and topics, including Open Access/Open Science
- Communication with authors, reviewers, publishing staff and other relevant parties
- Any other editorial or journal work deemed necessary

Specific duties

Specific duties for this role include:

- Day-to-day management and operations of the journal
- Sourcing special issues for the journal
- Commissioning special articles for the journal
- Liaising with the Editorial team, ECSS Publishing Manager and journal's Publisher
- Attendance at one or more journal editorial meeting per year to report on the journal's health and other news
- Attendance at one or more ECSS Executive Board meeting per year to report on the journal's health and other news
- Attendance at the ECSS Annual Congress to represent the journal

Expectations and requirements

- Qualified and respected within the community of sport science, with a strong international reputation and publishing record.
- Experience in an Editorial role for a sport science journal is preferred, e.g. Editor, Deputy Editor, Reviewing Editor, Associate Editor, Editorial Board Member.
- Experience with EJSS, e.g. as an Author, as a Reviewer or on the Editorial team.



- History with ECSS, e.g. as a Member, Fellow or Supporter of the College.
- Commitment to a minimum term of four years with the option for renewal.
