

Call for Papers on the 2nd China Duoba International Altitude Training and Health Forum

Each writer can only send 2 papers as the first writer. Abstracts either in English or Chinese are acceptable in this meeting.

The papers in Chinese should be scientific, advanced and practical, and the wording should be accurate, concise, clear and coherent. No figures and tables should be attached in abstracts. The papers should have four parts, namely purpose, methods, results and conclusion, no more than 1000 words in Chinese, 500 words in English. Please find the details in the attachment.

A. The requests on papers

The experiments and the results should be from 2009 to 2011. Each writer can only send 2 papers in this forum as the first writer and the proceedings publish the abstracts only.

The papers should be objective and do not involve the secrets. The writers should be responded to the papers.

The deadline of collecting papers is April 20th, 2011, register and send papers are by <http://www.duobaforum.org>

Please save the papers by the writers, the forum will not send back the papers.

We will recommendate all the papers for index and collecting, all the writers without the special introductions are allow their papers to index and collected.

B. Details about papers

a. Chinese abstract

The main part

Title: bold in middle. Empty a line at the beginning of the paper.

The writers: Kai Character, in the middle, empty with comma

between first name and last name.

The write unit and communicate address: The communicate address should be written as the province, city and zip code. Song Character in middle.

Key words: 3 to 5 words. The “key words” should be bolded, the others are in Song Character.

C. The main body of paper

a. Chinese abstract

The Chinese abstract should have about 1000 words. And the abstract should be advanced, practical, smooth, focus in point. The abstract should have 4 parts, namely intention, methods, results and conclusion. No tables and figures in abstract.

Unites in papers are in the national standard, such as hm^2 , kg, etc.

b. English abstract

About 500 words totally in English abstract. Use Times New Roman. The title should be bolded and in middle. The writer’s name is in middle. If one paper has several writers, use comma between each writers. The researches use the past voice, while use the present voice in the conclusion. There should be one line emptied between the writer’s unit and abstract and the main paper.

D. Reference

References should be marked in papers, then listed at the end of the paper. The word “reference” should be bolded and in the middle. And follow the international standards.

E. The brief introductions to writers

Please add the writer’s basic information at the bottom of the first page of the paper, no more than 100 words including the writer’s name, gender, degree, the study field, the ID number of CSSS, telephone number and E-mail.
