Furthermore the Kufstein Summer School will reflect the possibilities of creating new synergies with international NGOs, foundations and institutions such as the European Union with their various support programmes.

International experts from the field will discuss current projects and scientific discourse, in the tradition of ancient symposia. **Target groups** are graduate students of arts management, cultural studies, event management, tourism management, political sciences and heritage management; interested students of other fields are welcome.
